Please note that the stream <u>cannot be paused or rewound</u>, as it is a live broadcast.

How to Log In

For optimal experience, do select a higher quality video resolution according to your preference.

- right to pull up the Quality menu.

- right of the Settings cog.

Once the stream is open, click the Settings cog on the bottom

 Select 720p or 1080p for the best viewing experience. (We only recommend 1080p if you have a fast broadband connection.)

Wait 10-15 seconds for the resolution to update.

If the video quality is still low, click the Full-Screen icon to the

Connecting to your Television

- Use a **HDMI cable** to connect your laptop to your TV. The end of the cable that connects to your TV is shown on the left.
- Plug this cable into one of the HDMI sockets on your TV (eg. HDMI1, HDMI2, etc.)
- If you are using a Macbook, you may need a USB-C or Thunderbolt
 3 (USB-C) adapter to complete the connection.
- On your TV remote, press the Source button pictured on the left.
- Your TV will prompt you to select a source. Choose the HDMI source that was plugged from your device (eg. HDMI1, HDMI2, etc.).
